

Before Henry VIII outlawed pilgrimage and the veneration of saints in 1538, he route from London to the shrine at Walsingham in Norfolk was the most popular pilgrimage in England.

This guide follows a newly-resurrected 178-mile route. Divided into 13 stages, it's a truly uplifting walking experience, following footpaths and quiet lanes across the glorious east of England. The route has now been given **of-ficial recognition by the Confraternity of St James**, better known for their organisation of the Camino de Santiago in Spain. That means any pilgrim who walks at least 25km of it can use that 25km towards the total of 100km that must be walked to get the official *credencial* on reaching Santiago.
