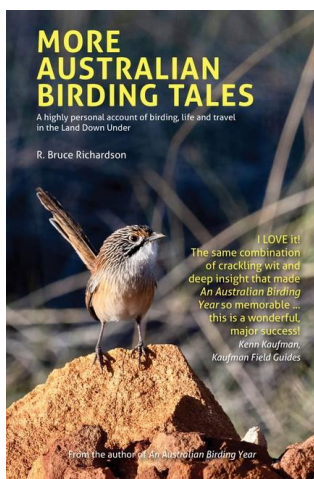


## An Australian Birding Year

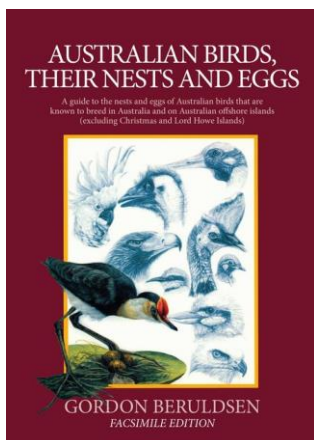


## More Australian Birding Tales
