Yet Breeden has persisted as one of the world's finest presenters of the splendours of nature right through to this new epoch of defiant environmental activism. His presentations through National Geographic, his marvellous books on nature, and his role in establishing Queensland's Wildlife Preservation Society, speak for themselves. The humble Stan Breeden wants a new Shakespeare to 'find words - full of drama and imagination - that make nature come alive in our minds.' We need only read this book.







This broad perspective goes well beyond Capone and specific acts of violence and brings to light what was happening elsewhere in Chicagoland and after Capone went to jail. Based on 25 years of research and using many previously unexplored sources, this fascinating account of a bloody and colourful era in Chicago history will become the definitive work on the subject.
