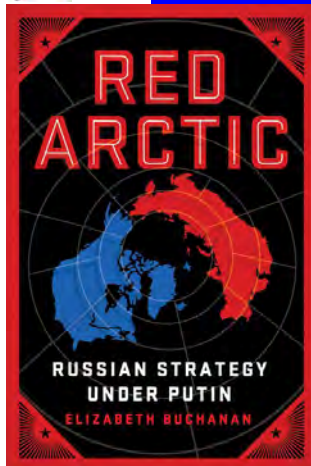

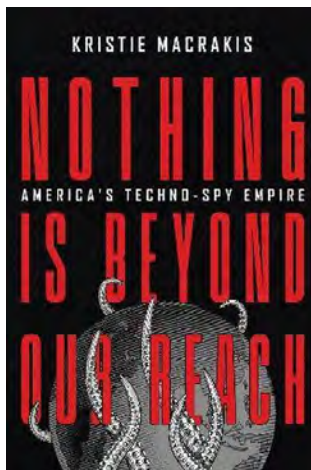


Red Arctic
Russian Strategy Under Putin

By Elizabeth Buchanan

The Arctic is a global bellwether for climate change and indigenous peoples' rights and traditions, as well as a "health check" on the durability of international laws and norms. Red Arctic challenges the widely held assumption that the Arctic is headed for strategic meltdown, emerging as a theatre for a literal (new) Cold War between Russia and the West. Buchanan explains that Putin's Arctic strategy relies heavily upon international cooperation with foreign energy firms and injections of foreign capital: conflict will be bad for business. Russia needs a "low tension" environment to deliver on Russia's critical economic interests. Red Arctic charts Arctic strategy under Putin from how it is formulated, what drives it, and where it's going. In cautioning against assumptions of expansionist intent in the region, Buchanan calls for informed judgment of the real drivers of Russian Arctic strategy.

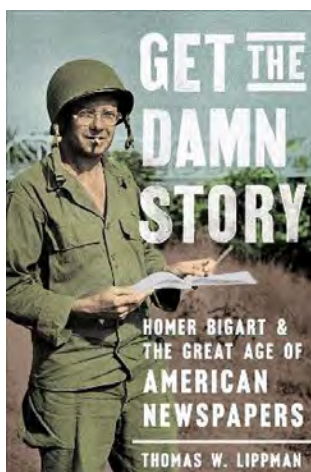


Nothing Is Beyond Our Reach

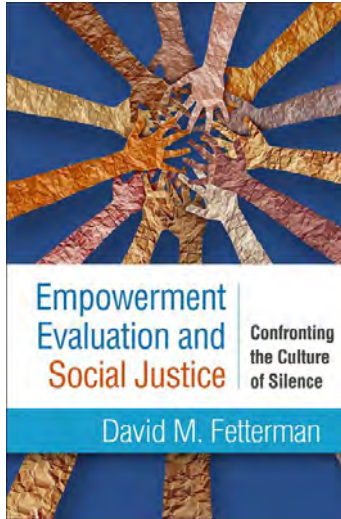
Get the Damn Story

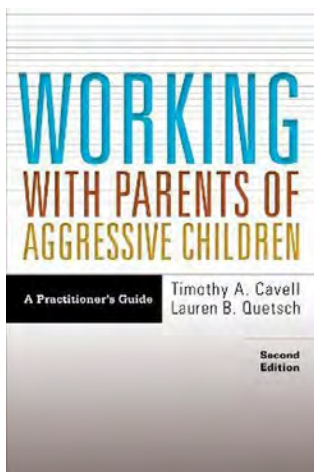


Attachment-Based Family Therapy for Sexual and Gender Minority Young Adults and Their Non-Accepting Parents

It is impossible to grow up in a culture in which heterosexist, homophobic, and transphobic messages are prevalent and not be impacted by such messages. Therefore, it is no wonder that most parents experience some degree of shame, fear, and loss upon learning that their own child is same-sex oriented or gender non-conforming. While most parents become more accepting, or at least more tolerant, over time, others remain partially or fully rejecting even years after learning of their child's identity. Ongoing parental criticism, invalidation, and rejection of one's sexual or gender identity can take a profound psychological toll and could lead to internalized homophobia, expectations for future gay-related rejection by others, depression, and other negative impacts.

In the decade that has passed since the first edition of this book was published, there has been a significant cultural shift towards the acceptance of LGBTQ people in the United States, yet there are many ways that institutional and interpersonal discrimination takes place in the lives of LGBTQ people. Even as the world changes for the better with the legalization of same-sex marriage, federal protections for LGBTQ people in the workplace, and more widespread acceptance of LGBTQ people- everyday homophobia and transphobia persists. Microaggressions are subtle, unconscious, and unintentional discrimination that is experienced by people of marginalized groups. In contrast to outright assaults and hate crimes, or conscious prejudicial treatment motivated by fear or dislike of "the other," microaggressions are more covert in nature, sometimes intentional or unintentional, communicating.

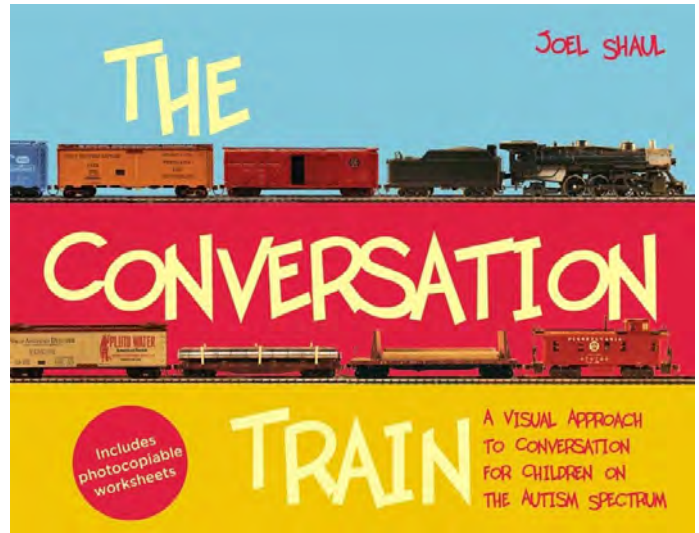
