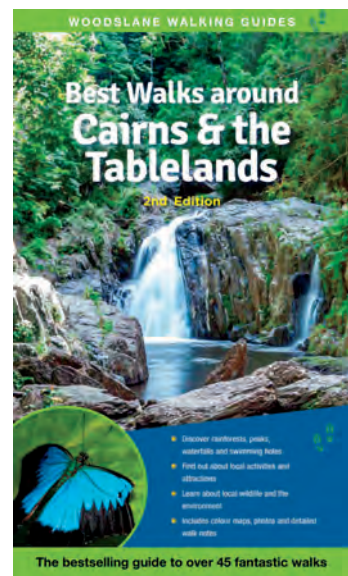

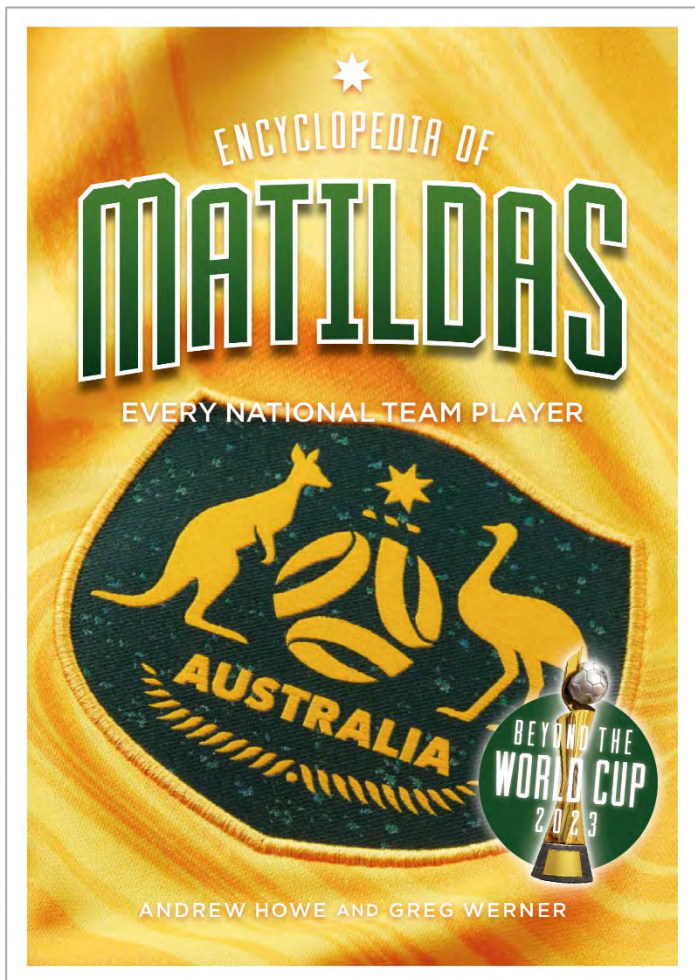

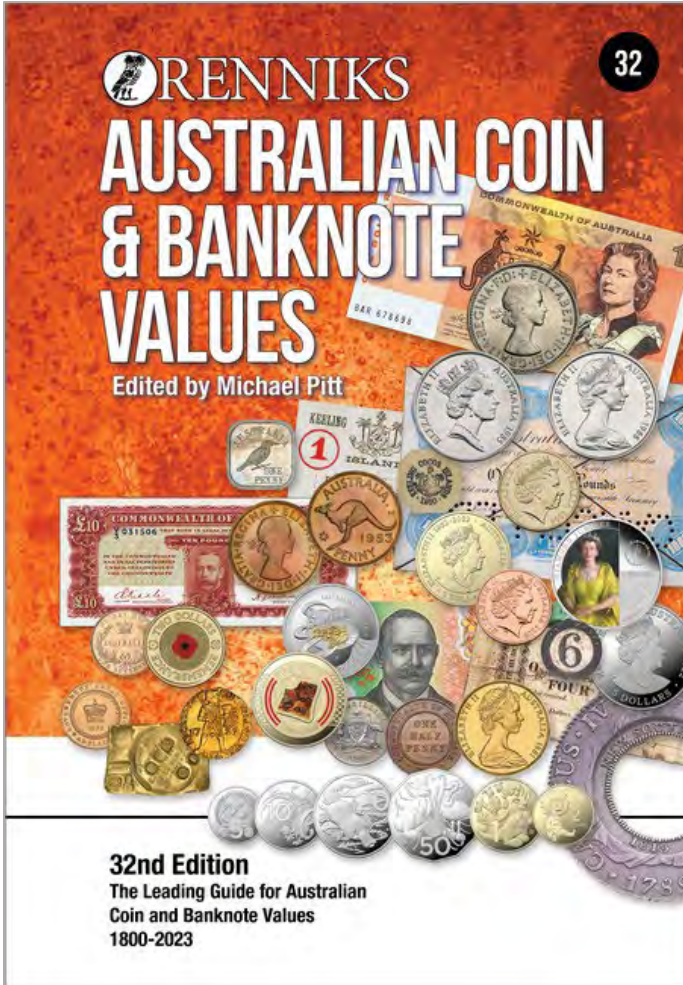

Growing up in the 1960s on Sydney’s upper North Shore, playing with Kissing Point & Wahroonga soccer clubs, Gregs connection with the national team was cemented early on hearing sideline stories of the talented Murray Barnes, who also played with Kissing Point and would go on to captain his country. That fascination grew over the decades working as an announcer, writer, and producer in rural and Sydney radio where, amongst other things, he wrote the history of sporting events covered by 2GB at the time.

Andrew Howe grew up in Sydney where his first sporting passion was for the Cronulla Sharks rugby league team and his academic ability was for statistics and history. Andrew attended his first national soccer league game between APIA Leichhardt and Marconi as a 19-year-old in 1988 and fell in love with the round ball code there and then. A Bachelor of Economics graduate from Macquarie University, Andrew’s sporting statistics career then developed alongside his professional career as a demographer with the Australian Bureau of Statistics. Andrews statistical record for Australian national teams, national leagues and the country’s players has been treated as the official record throughout this time. Andrew wrote his first guide for the national soccer league in 2000 and has compiled all men’s and women’s national league official guide since then.

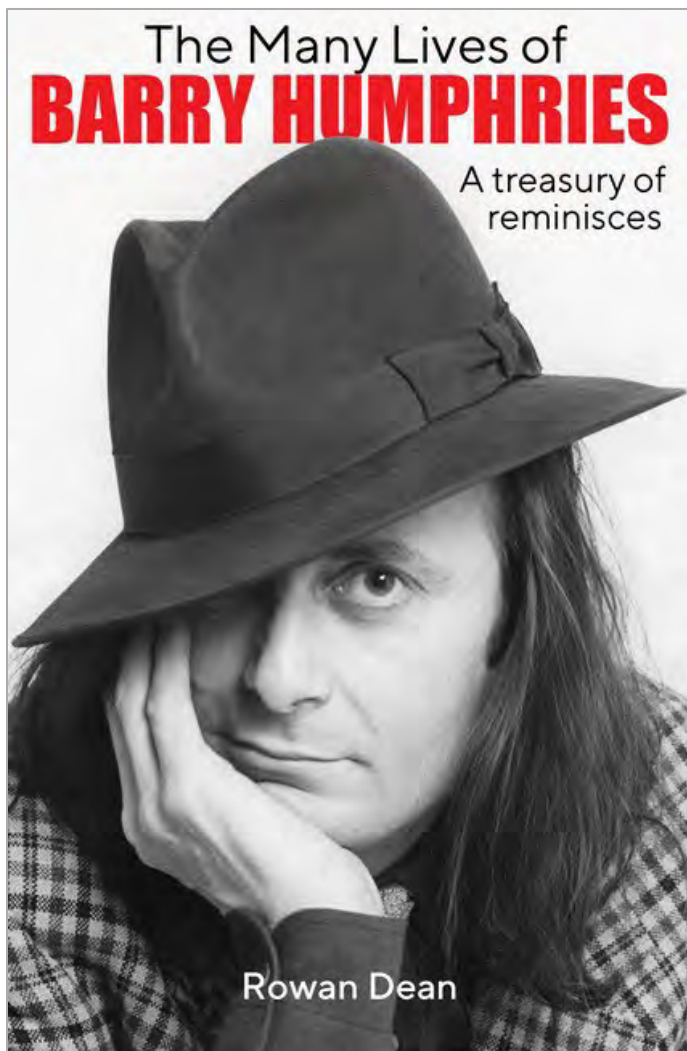

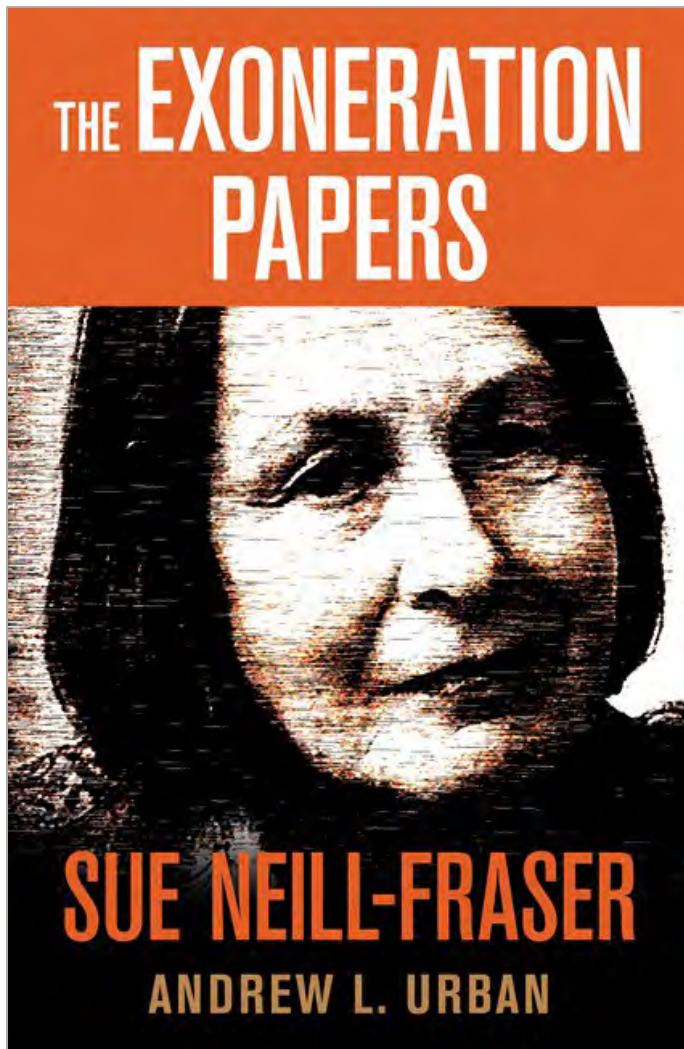

His first book, *Murder by the Prosecution* explored several wrongful convictions and was described by Margaret Cunneen SC as ‘troubling expose’. He has published the online *Wrongful Convictions Report* since 2018. He was Channel Host on *World Movies* for five years. He co-published with his wife Louise, the online movie magazine *Urban Cinefile* for 20 years. During his lifelong career as a journalist, he has had over 2,000 freelance articles published in a variety of publications in Australia and internationally.

In Vol.1, investigative journalist and author Andrew L. Urban traced the first stage of this shocking miscarriage of justice; in Vol.2 he reveals the full extent of a catastrophic failure of Tasmania’s legal system.

Now, after two dismal appeals that followed the trial, there are still plenty of grounds to appeal again – and to have the conviction quashed.

There is hope, but it needs the swell of public pressure to disarm the power of Tasmania’s legal ‘club’.

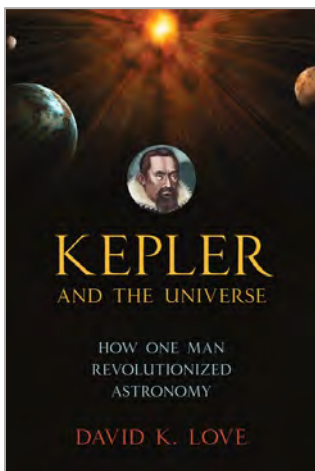
Escaping Winnie-the-Pooh

Cairns and around

The Cairns region changes dramatically in the late nineteenth and early twentieth century as the first European colonists arrived. As elsewhere, this had big implications for indigenous people. With mining in the region the population grew and water was required. Some of these waterfalls later provide the hydroelectric power used in the early days of European settlement, with a growing population and the city's expansion the region continues to change, yet still retains its magic for many.

In the Tablelands the combination of warm temperatures, high rainfall and partially mountainous areas of the Tablelands is a joy to see. It also means waterfalls are plentiful, especially in the wet season after rain. Fresh water swimming holes enable cooling off in a beautiful environment without fear of mosquitos or marine stings.

As the Tablelands are so biodiverse you have the chance of seeing many different species. Of all the species to be found in Australia, more than half of the bushbirds and ferns, 40% of the bats, and 40% of the bats live in the region.

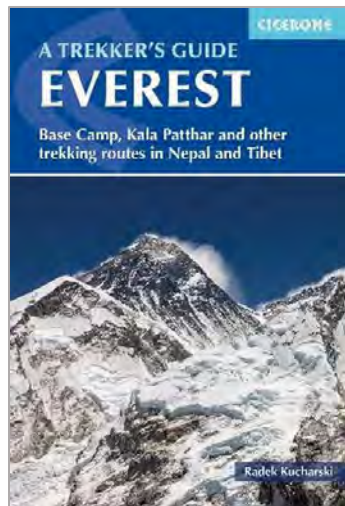


1 Mount Whitfield 'Arrow' Tracks

The Red, Blue, Green and Yellow Arrow tracks up and around Mount Whitfield. Conservation Park at Edge Hill in Cairns are popular amongst walkers and joggers and offer views of Cairns, the coast and surrounding hills. Climbing uphill is involved with each track through the rainforest in difficult terrain. They are well signposted and are accessible by private or hire vehicles to arrive in the relevant colour.

These tracks travel through a range of vegetation and it is interesting to note the variety growing around one big hill. In some sections, e.g. the Yellow Arrow track, the trees are relatively small and tall reaching parts of the hill. Study the map and choose which options you want to do - you probably won't need to walk all the tracks in one day. Also take in mind that, since you commit yourself to the Blue loop you will be up there for a while, so take water enough in the day to ensure you will be back down well before dusk.

Some animals have unique ways of showing aggression, such as the ghost crab (*Gecarcinus lateralis*) found along most Australian shorelines. Not only does it use its powerful claws to show aggression but it also grows its predators using teeth in its stomach!

Alarm response
A signal from an animal to warn others of danger. These can include visual signals, calls, thumps and even smells. Australian didemnon (such as the red-necked didemnon, *Thylogalea thiesi*), thump their bodies on the ground as an alarm response.

Agonistic behaviour
Animal behaviour that relates to fighting but is not necessarily aggressive behaviour. This includes aggression, defence, submission and retreat.

Albinism
A mutation that affects the production of melanin, a pigment responsible for the colour in eyes, skin, fur and leaves. Without melanin, animals and plants cannot produce their usual colour and will instead be pure white. See also leucism.

Migaloo the humpback whale (*Megaptera novaeangliae*) is a famous example of an albino animal. He has been sighted periodically off the coast of Australia since 1991, and on Bruny Island, Tasmania, there is a community of albino Bennett's wallabies (*Notanoplos rufogilvescens*) where the genetic mutation has become common.
